## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Cultural Wheel

After studying the "Cultural Universals" and giving real life examples, it is now time to apply what we have learned. You will be creating a *Cultural Wheel of Crested Butte*. The *Wheel* will be made up of the six universals (**religion**, **family**, **economy**, **environmental interaction**, **technology**, **and government**) and must be specific to our life in Crested Butte. Each universal will be given its own piece of the wheel and will have a definition of the universal (ex: <u>technology</u> – anything that makes life easier). In addition to the definition, you will give two examples of culture for each universal (ex: <u>technology</u> – a lighter used to start a fire). You will need to draw the example and label what it is.

- 3. Define the six universals.
- 4. Cut out or draw at least two pictures of examples for each universal.
