Study Steps:

Review Sheet Example – the Pope.

1. *Define* the term, person or place.

The leader of the Roman Catholic Church. The Bishop of Rome.

2. Give an *example* of the term, person, or place (incorporate significance).

The Pope had the power to name Charlemagne the Emperor of Europe – he was that powerful.

3. Use the term, person, or place in a complete *sentence*.

The Pope is the most powerful figure in the Roman Catholic Church. He decides Church doctrine.

4. Come up with an *opposite* for the term, place, or person.

The laity is made up of the lowest members of the Church – the average people.
