

Part I: As a class, we have studied the historical background and importance of Christianity. We also covered the culture of Christianity in modern society. Now, you will summarize the beliefs and culture of Christianity by answering the following questions. Topics include:

- *Worship*
- *Key Prophets*
- *Core Beliefs*
- *Holidays*
- *Branches of Christianity*
- *Subtopics from 'other' category*

For each topic, you will describe how it relates to the overall culture of Christianity. You will need to use both written (in full sentences) and visual descriptions.

Worship: (notes)

- Where do followers worship?
- What is the holy book?
- Who leads traditional Christian worship?
- Describe the inside of a Church (draw a church layout)

Key Prophets: (pgs. 87, 91, 344-350)

- What is a prophet?

- Who are the key prophets of Christianity? (list at least 2)

- Why are these prophets important?

- What does 'disciple' mean?

- What does 'apostle' mean?

- When did Christianity begin?

- Where did Christianity begin?

Core Beliefs: (pgs. 343-350, notes)

- What are the core beliefs that all Christians share?

- What is the 'Holy Trinity'?

Holidays: (packet)

- What are the major Christian holidays? (list 3)

- What does each celebrate?

- How is it celebrated? (What do *followers of Christianity* do? What do *non-Christians* sometimes do?)

Branches of Christianity: (Packet/Notes)

- List and describe the three major branches of Christianity
 - How do these branches differ?

- List and describe 3 sub-groups of Christianity (Lutheran Church, Evangelical Church, Baptist, Quakers, etc.)

- Clothing:
 - Do any Christian groups have clothing specifications?

- Diet:

Using color and the map provided, show the growth of Christianity for the following time periods: (Pg 361)

- Christian areas prior (before) 325 AD
- Christian areas added by 400 AD
- Christian areas added by 600 AD

On your map, label the following cities: (pg 361)

- Jerusalem
- Damascus
- Constantinople
- Rome
- Alexandria
